A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMPLETION OF A NEW ARTS  
CENTER IN LENOIR COUNTY.

Whereas, the Community Council for the Arts provides the citizens of  
Kinston and Lenoir County with access to social, cultural, and educational benefits; and

Whereas, the Community Council for the Arts has made great progress in the  
renovation of a vacant building known as the Midyette Hardware Store located in  
downtown Kinston into a model arts center; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lenoir County the  
sum of \$300,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to meet obligations toward the completion  
of a new arts center in the Midyette Hardware Store Building, provided \$600,000 in  
local funds are raised by Lenoir County and the City of Kinston to match this  
appropriation on a two-to-one basis.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
