- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 7 section to read:
- 8 "<u>§ 58-3-155. Requiring specific repair companies forbidden.</u>

9 It shall be unlawful for any insurance company doing business in this State to

10 require the use of a particular repair source, service, or company as a condition

- 11 precedent to paying a valid claim for property damage under any policy."
- 12 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
