G.S. 130A-309.10 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(f1) After January 1, 1996, all disposable glass containers distributed, sold, or offered for sale in this State shall be a uniform color. This subsection does not apply to disposable glass containers which the Department has determined need to be a different color in order to process or store certain chemical products." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
