April 19, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FROM PROCEEDING WITH ANY CONSTRUCTION **PROJECT** IN **AREAS** CONTAINING HABITATS OF THE RED-COCKADED WOODPECKER. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 136-102.7. Protection of red-cockaded woodpecker habitats. The Department of Transportation shall not proceed with any construction project if the area of that project contains colonies of the red-cockaded woodpecker (Picoides borealis) and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service has issued a jeopardy biological opinion, as defined in 50 C.F.R. § 402.14 stating that the project is likely to jeopardize the continued existence of the red-cockaded woodpecker." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
