

1 Sciences, have developed a program that would enable the science museums of the State
2 to resolve some of these concerns; and

3 Whereas, a Grassroots Science Program would provide consistent support to
4 science museums that would allow the development of a State science outreach program
5 that would, in time, be comparable to the State's program of support for the arts; Now
6 therefore,

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
9 Agriculture the sum of one million nine hundred eighteen thousand dollars (\$1,918,000)
10 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the development of a grassroots science program by the
11 Museum of Natural Sciences to serve local museums and nature centers.

12 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
