1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
3 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
4 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
5 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain
8 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, of the capital
9 improvements projects listed in Section 2 of this act for each institution, and to
10 authorize the financing of these capital improvements projects with funds available to
11 the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds,
12 or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from the
13 General Fund of the State.

14 Sec. 2. The projects authorized to be constructed and financed as provided in
15 Section 1 of this act are as follows:

17 a. Student Housing \$7,730,600
18 b. Dormitory Addition and Renovations 9,202,500
19 (2) East Carolina University
20 a. Renovation of Minges Coliseum 4,255,900
21 (3) Fayetteville State University
22 a. Addition - New Residence Hall 3,285,100
23 (4) The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill

9           Sec. 3. At the request of The University of North Carolina Board of  
10 Governors and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the  
11 Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change  
12 in the method of funding for any project authorized by this act. In making a  
13 determination of whether to authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the  
14 Budget may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission. In no event shall  
15 appropriations from the General Fund be used for a project authorized by this act.

16           Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
