A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES,
2 DIVISION OF AGING, TO CHARGE FEES FOR IN-HOME AND
3 COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 143B-181.1(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
7 read:

8 "(10) Unless prohibited by federal law, to charge fees for in-home and
9 community-based services funded by the Division. Fees for services
10 to be paid by recipients of services shall be based on a sliding fee
11 scale. The Division of Aging shall establish policies governing the
12 collection and reporting of fees. Fees collected under the authority of
13 this subdivision shall be used to extend the availability of in-home and
14 community-based services funded by the Division in support of
15 functionally impaired older adults and/or their family caregivers."

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1992.
