A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
RESOURCES TO CONTRACT WITH ORGANIZATIONS FOR SERVICES
RELATED TO THE PREVENTION OF YOUTH SUICIDE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Office for Children and the Family, the sum of \$25,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year, and the sum of \$25,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year, to award contracts to public or private nonprofit organizations, agencies, schools, or hospitals, that offer programs or services designed to prevent youth suicide. The Department shall develop application procedures and eligibility guidelines for the awarding of contracts; provided that all State funds paid under such contracts shall be used solely for programs implemented and services delivered within North Carolina.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
