G.S. 163-195 reads as rewritten: 8 "§ 163-195. Secretary of State to record abstracts and certified general election 9 10 results. The Secretary of State shall record the State, district, and county abstracts 11 filed with him by the State Board of Elections in a book to be kept by him for that 12 13 purpose. (b) Within seven days after the county board of elections meets to canvass the 14 15 returns for the general election, the chairman of that board shall mail, or otherwise deliver, to the Secretary of State certified results of elections for:President and Vice 16 President of the United States 17 18 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and all other State executive officers 19 United States Senators Members of the House of Representatives of the United States Congress 20 Justices, Judges, and District Attorneys of the General Court of Justice 21 22 **State Senators** 23 Members of the State House of Representatives

1 Constitutional amendments and propositions submitted to the voters of the State." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
