A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO SAFE DRIVER INCENTIVE PLAN POINTS
3 SHALL BE ASSESSED FOR THE FIRST ACCIDENT WITHIN THREE YEARS
4 IF THERE IS PROPERTY DAMAGE ONLY AND NO MOVING VIOLATION
5 INVOLVED.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 58-36-75 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

8 "(a1) The subclassification plan shall provide that with respect to the first accident
9 involving property damage only, with no moving traffic violations involved, and after
10 an insured has been covered by liability insurance for five years or more, there shall be
11 no premium surcharge or any assessment of points unless there is a driving record
12 consisting of a conviction or convictions for a moving traffic violation or violations
13 during the three years immediately preceding the date of application or preparation of
14 the renewal."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
