5	Secti	on 1. G.S. 136-176(b) reads as rewritten:	
6	"(b) Fund	s in the Trust Fund are annually appropriated to the Department of	
7	Transportation	to be allocated and used as provided in this subsection. A sum, not to	
8	exceed five percent (5%)-four and one-half percent (4 1/2%) of the amount of revenue		
9	deposited in the Trust Fund under subdivisions (a)(1), (2), and (3) of this section, may		
10	be used each fiscal year by the Department for expenses to administer the Trust Fund.		
11	The rest of the funds in the Trust Fund shall be allocated and used as follows:		
12	(1)	Sixty-one and ninety-five hundredths percent (61.95%) to plan, design,	
13		and construct the projects of the Intrastate System described in G.S.	
14		136-179.	
15	(2)	Twenty-five and five hundredths percent (25.05%) to plan, design, and	
16		construct the urban loops described in G.S. 136-180.	
17	(3)	Six and one-half percent (6.5%) to supplement the appropriation to	
18		cities for city streets under G.S. 136-181.	
19	(4)	Six and one-half percent (6.5%) for secondary road construction as	
20		provided in G.S. 136-182."
