SENATE BILL 496

Short Title: Holly Ridge Solid Waste Fee.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF HOLLY RIDGE TO COLLECT A FEE
FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SYSTEMS AND
FACILITIES IN THE SAME MANNER AS AD VALOREM TAXES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 1007 of the 1989 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Sec. 2. (a) A city may provide that any fee imposed under G.S. 160A-314 for
the purpose of G.S. 160A-311(6) may be billed with the ad valorem taxes, may be
payable in the same manner as ad valorem taxes, and, in the case of nonpayment, the
same remedies may be used by a city to collect such fees as are used to collect
delinquent ad valorem taxes.

(b) This section applies to Surf City and the Town of Holly Ridge only."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees imposed on
or after July 1, 1991. ♦
