Feed Advisory Service; fee. The Department of Agriculture shall establish as a pilot program, operate a Feed 6 Advisory Service for the analysis of animal feeds in order to provide a feeding management service to all animal producers in North Carolina. A fee of ten dollars 8 (\$10.00) shall accompany each feed sample sent to the Department for testing. A fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) shall accompany each feed sample which is to be tested 10 for the presence of fumonisin." 11

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
