CHAPTER 649 SENATE BILL 508

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR FEED TESTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 106-21.1 reads as rewritten:

"§ 106-21.1. Feed Advisory Service; fee.

The Department of Agriculture shall establish as a pilot program, operate a Feed Advisory Service for the analysis of animal feeds in order to provide a feeding management service to all animal producers in North Carolina. A fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall accompany each feed sample sent to the Department for testing. A fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) shall accompany each feed sample which is to be tested for the presence of fumonisin."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 13th day of July, 1991.
