A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PERMIT THE UTILITIES COMMISSION TO EXEMPT CELLULAR
FROM REGULATION UNDER CHAPTER 62.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Article 6A of Chapter 62 is amended by adding a new section to
read:
"§ 62-125. Exemption for cellular telephone service.
Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Commission may, to the extent it
finds such services to be competitive and such action in the public interest, exempt
domestic public cellular radio telecommunications service providers, if licensed by the
Federal Communications Commission, from regulation under any or all of the
provisions of this Chapter. Nothing in this section shall be construed to diminish any
other authority granted the Commission in this Chapter."
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
