A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF UNMARKED LAW ENFORCEMENT CARS
FOR ROUTINE TRAFFIC STOPS AT NIGHT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

**"§ 20-196.4. No routine traffic stops by unmarked law enforcement vehicles at
night.**

Unmarked law enforcement vehicles shall not be used to make routine traffic stops
between one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
