A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION ADOPT
2 RULES SETTING STATE/COUNTY SPECIAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY
3 FOR DOMICILIARY CARE TO CORRESPOND WITH THE RULES
4 DETERMINING FEDERAL MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 108A-41(c) reads as rewritten:

8 "(c) When determining whether a person has insufficient resources to provide a
9 reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, there shall be excluded
10 from consideration ~~the person's primary place of residence and the land on which it is~~
11 ~~situated, and in addition there shall be excluded real property contiguous with the~~
12 ~~person's primary place of residence in which the property tax value is less than twelve~~
13 ~~thousand dollars (\$12,000); the same resources determined by the reserve and asset~~
14 calculation for the Federal Medicaid Program, including calculations for married
15 persons. "

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
