1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A MAINTENANCE RESERVE FOR STATE 3 BUILDINGS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 143-10.3. Capital budget to include Maintenance Reserve for State Buildings.

There is created the Maintenance Reserve for State Buildings. The reserve shall be used for the repair and renovation of State buildings and for the replacement of State buildings. The General Assembly shall set aside each year a portion of the General Fund revenues and shall appropriate such amount to the reserve in the Capital Improvements Appropriations Act. A specific portion of the amount appropriated shall be designated for repairs and renovations. The reserve shall be administered by the Office of State Budget and Management, and funds up to the amount designated for repairs and renovations shall be allocated based on repair and renovation priorities derived from the Facility Condition Assessment Program of the Office of State Construction."
