1 A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE MEMORY OF GOVERNOR  
2 RICHARD CASWELL AND CELEBRATING THE 200TH ANNIVERSARY OF  
3 LENOIR COUNTY.

4       Whereas, Lenoir County is celebrating its bicentennial in 1991; and

5       Whereas, Lenoir County was formed from a portion of Dobbs County; and

6       Whereas, Lenoir County was named for William Lenoir, one of the heroes of  
7 the Battle of Kings Mountain during the Revolutionary War; and

8       Whereas, Richard Caswell, the first Governor of North Carolina after the  
9 independence of this country, was born in Lenoir County; and

10       Whereas, Governor Caswell served six one-year terms and is buried at the  
11 Caswell-Neuse State Park in Lenoir County; and

12       Whereas, the citizens of Lenoir County have been actively preparing a  
13 celebration to honor this historic occasion with a reenactment of the inauguration of  
14 Governor Caswell on April 26th, 27th, and 28th;

15 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Senate;

16       Section 1. The Senate honors the memory of Governor Richard Caswell on  
17 the 200th anniversary of Lenoir County.

18       Sec. 2. The Senate urges all citizens of this State to join Lenoir County in  
19 celebrating its bicentennial.

20       Sec. 3. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to  
21 the chairman of Lenoir County Board of Commissioners and the mayor of the City of  
22 Kinston.

23       Sec. 4. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
