A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT PUBLIC AIRPORT TRAFFIC SIGNS FROM THE
REQUIREMENT FOR UNIFORM SIGNS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES
ON HIGHWAYS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 136-30 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(e) Exception for Public Airport Traffic Signs. – Publicly owned airports, as defined in Chapter 63 of the General Statutes, shall be exempt from the requirements of subsections (b) and (c) of this section with respect to informational and directional signs, but not with respect to regulatory traffic signs."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
