A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE BUSING FOR ALL CHILDREN IN KINDERGARTEN
THROUGH GRADE 5, REGARDLESS OF HOW CLOSE THEY LIVE TO
THEIR SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-242(4) reads as rewritten:

"(4) A local board of education which that elects to operate a school bus transportation system, system shall not be required to provide transportation for any school employee, nor shall such the board be required to provide transportation for any pupil in grades 6 through 12 living within one and one half miles of the school in which such the pupil is enrolled."

Sec. 2. G.S. 115C-246(b) reads as rewritten:

- "(b) Unless road or other conditions shall make it inadvisable to do so, public school buses shall be so routed on State-maintained highways that the school bus, to bus to which such a pupil is assigned, shall pass within one mile of the residence of each pupil, pupil in grades 6 through 12 who lives one and one half miles or more from the school to which such the pupil is assigned. assigned and within one mile of the residence of each pupil in grades kindergarten through 5."
  - Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July  $\overline{1, 1993}$ .
