A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO CONFORM STATE GAS PIPELINE PENALTY STANDARDS TO THE NEWLY ENACTED AMENDMENTS TO THE FEDERAL NATURAL GAS 3 4 PIPELINE SAFETY ACT OF 1968.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 62-50(d) reads as rewritten:

Any person who violates any provision of this section, or any regulation of the Utilities Commission issued thereunder, shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each violation for each day that the violation persists, the maximum civil penalty not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for any continuing violation. continues. The maximum penalty for each day of a violation and for all the days of a continuing violation may not exceed the maximum penalties that would apply if the penalties had been imposed under 49 U.S.C. Appx. § 1679a(a) by the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation.

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- Penalties assessed under this subsection shall be credited to the General Fund as nontax 15 revenue." 16

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Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
