The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 20-7 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 6 7 "(n1) Any person whose drivers license, commercial drivers license, or other privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this State has been revoked or canceled pursuant to G.S. 20-13.2(b) or G.S. 20-17.4(a)(1) shall be reissued only a drivers or commercial 9 drivers license with a restrictive code as determined by the Commissioner. 10 The Commissioner may remove the restrictive code if the person does the following 12 and provides satisfactory proof to the Commissioner: a. That the person has obtained a substance abuse assessment from an 13 (1) area mental health agency, its designated agent, or private facility 14 licensed by the State for the treatment of alcoholism and substance 15 abuse. 16 17 If the assessing agency recommended that the person participate b. 18 in a treatment program: 19 That the person participated in a treatment program; That the person executed a Release of Information 20 authorizing the treatment agency to report the person's 22 completion of the treatment program
