2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMMUNITY COORDINATORS TO 3 ESTABLISH AND COORDINATE A SCHOOL SAFETY TASK FORCE IN

- 4 EACH LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 7 Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of 8 two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to 9 provide funding for a half-time community coordinator for each local school 10 administrative unit. The coordinator shall coordinate the work of a School Safety Task 11 Force appointed by the local board of education and composed of students, parents, 12 educators, law enforcement and court personnel, local government representatives, and 13 community leaders. The Task Force shall (i) evaluate the extent of violence present in 14 the schools and in the community, (ii) develop a plan that includes strategies for 15 preventing violence and intervening in violent situations, and (iii) report the plan to the 16 local board of education. 17
