A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS FOR3 SUSPENDED STUDENTS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 5 Public Education, Department of Public Instruction, the sum of one million six hundred 6 thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million six 7 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year. These funds shall be 8 allocated to local boards of education to be used exclusively for the establishment and 9 operation of alternative educational programs for students suspended from school 10 11 pursuant to G.S. 115C-391(c). 12 The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to assure that these programs

- provide quality instruction to suspended students and teach discipline and prevention ofviolent conduct.
