Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of nineteen million forty-two thousand six hundred sixteen dollars (\$19,042,616) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of nineteen million forty-two thousand six hundred sixteen dollars (\$19,042,616) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for annual longevity payments at one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of base salary for 10 to 14 years of State service, two and one-quarter percent (2 1/4%) of base salary for 15 to 19 years of State service, three and one-half percent (4 1/2%) of base salary for 20 to 24 years of State service, and four and one-half percent (4 1/2%) of base salary for 25 years of State service, commencing July 1, 1993, for all teachers whose salaries are supported from the State's General Fund.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
