A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING WITH FIREARMS FROM PUBLIC ROADS IN  
CABARRUS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill with the use of firearms, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill with the use of firearms, any bird or game animal, or to discharge a firearm from, on, or across the right-of-way of any numbered highway maintained by the State of North Carolina.

Sec. 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

Sec. 3. This act is enforceable by officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

Sec. 4. This act applies only to Cabarrus County.
