- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
- 3 RESOURCES, DIVISION OF AGING, TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM WHICH
- 4 UTILIZES OLDER ADULT VOLUNTEERS IN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS
- 5 FOR AT-RISK MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS.6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 8 Human Resources, Division of Aging, the sum of two million five hundred twenty 9 thousand dollars (\$2,520,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop a program which 10 utilizes older adult volunteers in comprehensive after-school programs that target at-risk 11 middle school students. These funds shall be used to cover training, stipends, and other 12 support costs for the volunteers in one-half of the middle schools and junior high 13 schools in the State. This program shall be administered by the Department of Human
- 14 Resources, Division of Aging, and should be compatible with federal guidelines for the
- 15 Foster Grandparent Program.
