Beauty parlor, etc. 6 'Cosmetic art shop,' 'beauty parlor,' or 'hairdressing establishment' is any building, or 7 part thereof wherein cosmetic art is practiced, practiced; provided that an individual 8 rental booth is not a cosmetic art shop. and a A 'beauty school,' 'beauty college,' or 'beauty academy' is any building or part thereof wherein cosmetic art is taught." 10 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 11
