A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE PROHIBITIONS ON HUNTING MALE DEER ON THE
2 OUTER BANKS OF CURRITUCK COUNTY AND ON BEAR HUNTING IN
3 CURRITUCK COUNTY, AND TO AUTHORIZE SEASONS FOR TAKING
4 DEER WITH SHOTGUNS ON A PORTION OF THE OUTER BANKS OF
5 CURRITUCK COUNTY AND FOR HUNTING BLACK BEARS IN CURRITUCK
6 COUNTY.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 Section 1. Chapter 494 of the 1977 Session Laws is repealed.

10 Sec. 2. Section 3 of Chapter 582 of the 1979 Session Laws reads as
11 rewritten:

12 "Sec. 3. This act applies only to the counties of Camden, Chowan, ~~Currituck~~, Dare,
13 Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell and Washington."

14 Sec. 3. G.S. 113-133.1(e) is amended by deleting: "Currituck: Session Laws
15 1959, Chapter 545; Session Laws 1977, Chapter 494; Session Laws 1979, Chapter
16 582.", and substituting "Currituck: Session Laws 1959, Chapter 545."

17 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season
18 for hunting or taking antlered deer with shotguns no larger than 10 gauge in:

19 (1) That portion of Poplar Branch Township on the Outer Banks of
20 Currituck County; and

21 (2) The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Swan Island and Monkey Island
22 Refuge Areas on the Outer Banks of Currituck County;

23 from October 18, 1993, through January 1, 1994, and in subsequent years as established
24 by the Wildlife Resources Commission.

1 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season
2 for hunting or taking black bear in:

3 (1) That portion of Currituck County south and west of U.S. Highway
4 158; and

5 (2) All of Poplar Branch Township except that portion on the Outer Banks
6 of Currituck County;

7 from November 8, 1993, through November 13, 1993, and in subsequent years as
8 established by the Wildlife Resources Commission.

9 Sec. 6. This act applies only to Currituck County.

10 Sec. 7. This act is effective upon ratification.
