A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H
2 PROGRAM.

4 Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Camps are owned by the State, or deeded to
5 North Carolina State University, an entity of the State; and

6 Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of
7 these facilities; and

8 Whereas, these facilities provide educational and recreational services to
9 more than 10,000 North Carolina families each year representative of the State
10 population; and

11 Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000
12 contributed by citizen volunteers; and

13 Whereas, the 4-H Youth Development Program at NCSU agrees to raise
14 \$250,000 from the private sector to match these funds for the youth of North Carolina;
15 Now, therefore,

16 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

17 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
18 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred fifty thousand
19 dollars (\$250,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Youth
20 Development Program at North Carolina State University for camp operation funds for
21 the North Carolina 4-H Camp Program and the general support of these programs.

22 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
