7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 135-40.6 is amended by adding the following new
9	subdivision:
10	"(10) Coverage for Services of Advanced Practice Registered Nurses. –
11	Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or the Plan,
12	benefits shall be payable for services performed by an advanced
13	practice registered nurse subject to the following limitations:
14	<u>a.</u> The service performed is within the nurse's lawful scope of
15	practice;
16	<u>b.</u> <u>The Plan provides benefits for identical services performed by</u>
17	other licensed health care providers;
18	c. The service is not performed while the nurse is a regular
19	employee in an office of a licensed physician;
20	d. The service is not performed while the nurse is employed by a
21 22	nursing facility (including a hospital, skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facility, or home care agency); and
44	intermediate care facility, or nome care agency, and

The supervising physician has not obtained an assignment of 1 e. 2 and is not otherwise entitled to the benefits under the Plan. 3 No lack of signature, referral, or employment by any other health care provider may be asserted to deny benefits under this subdivision. 4 5 For purposes of this section, an 'advanced practice registered nurse' 6 means only a registered nurse who is duly licensed or certified as a 7 nurse practitioner, clinical specialist in psychiatric and mental health 8 nursing, registered nurse anesthetist, nurse midwife, or clinical nurse 9 specialist." 10

Sec. 2. G.S. 135-40.7(5) reads as rewritten:

- Charges for any care, treatment, services or supplies other than those "(5)which are certified by a physician who is attending the individual as being required for the medically necessary treatment of the injury or disease. This subdivision shall not be construed, however, to require certification by an attending physician for a service provided by an advanced practice registered nurse acting within the nurse's lawful scope of practice, subject to the limitations of G.S. 135-40.6(10)."
- Sec. 3. G.S. 135-40.7B(c) reads as rewritten:
- Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Part, the following providers are authorized to provide necessary care and treatment for mental illness under this section: licensed psychiatrists and doctors of psychology licensed or certified in their states of practice, psychiatric nurses psychiatric nurses, or social workers or psychological associates with a master's degree in psychology under the direct employment and supervision of a licensed psychiatrist or licensed or certified doctor of psychology, licensed psychiatric hospitals and licensed general hospitals providing psychiatric treatment programs and certified residential treatment facilities, community mental health centers, and partial hospitalization facilities."
  - Sec. 4. G.S. 135-40.7A(c)(3) reads as rewritten:
  - Duly licensed physicians and duly licensed practicing psychologists psychologists, certified clinical specialists in psychiatric and mental health nursing, and certified professionals working under the direct supervision of such physicians or psychologists in facilities described in (1) and (2) above and in day/night programs or outpatient treatment facilities licensed after July 1, 1984, under Article 2 of General Statutes Chapter 122C."
  - Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.

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
