A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD FOR THE GASTON
2 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SO IT WILL CLOSE PRIOR TO THE
3 AVAILABILITY OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 633, Session Laws of 1977, as amended by
7 Chapter 331, Session Laws of 1979, reads as rewritten:

8 "Sec. 4. Ballot; notice of candidacy and residence requirements. The names of the
9 candidates shall be placed on a separate ballot bearing no party designation, and no
10 party affiliation need be indicated at the time of filing. Each candidate shall file a notice
11 of candidacy with the board of elections indicating whether he is running as a member
12 at large or from a particular township at any time after 12:00 noon on the Friday
13 preceding the ~~sixteenth~~eighteenth Saturday and before 12:00 noon on the Friday
14 preceding the ~~twelfth~~fourteenth Saturday before the general election. A candidate
15 seeking to represent a particular township shall be a resident and qualified voter of said
16 township."

17 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
