A JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A SYSTEM TO DEVELOP AND 1 2 IMPLEMENT A SYSTEM FOR BUILDING IMPROVEMENT REPORTS. 3 Whereas, the 1991 General Assembly charged the State Board of Education to develop a system of school building improvement reports for each school building; 4 5 and 6 Whereas, the building improvement reports are intended to regularly and 7 systematically report school progress to the parents and citizens of the communities served by the schools; and 8 9 Whereas, the State Board of Education developed a system and reported its plan to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on December 1, 1992; and 10 Whereas, the 1991 General Assembly charged the Joint Legislative Education 11 Oversight Committee to submit a proposed plan for school building reports to the 1993 12 13 General Assembly for its approval; and 14 Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee reviewed the plan submitted by the State Board of Education which includes technical assistance by 15 the Department of Public Instruction to local units so that those units may by computer 16 program use local test data to create unique reports for each school building; and 17 Whereas, according to the State Board Report all building reports will include 18 the following minimum information: 19 20 Average daily attendance; 21 The number and percent of students in each of the following categories: 22 race, gender, gifted, handicapped, and those educationally disadvantaged;

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1       Number and types of staff members by category;         2       Student/teacher ratios;         3       Characteristics of classroom teachers;         4       Parent education levels;         5       Percent of students eligible for free and reduced lunch;         6       Absentee rates;         7       Student performance;         8       Postgraduation performance and participation;         10       Advanced placement performance and participation;         11       Diploma and certificate ratios; and         12       Graduation, retention, and dropout rates; and         13       Whereas, the State Board plan recommended but did not require that school         14       reports disaggregate school performance data by race and gender; and         15       Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee finds that         16       specifically target the needs and school performance of specific populations; and         18       Whereas, the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee finds that the         19       State Board plan mentions but does not emphasize that building improvement reports         20       shall specifically report on progress made on each building's unique goals for qualitative         21       improvement, for example, increased parent involvement and welcome or dynamic         23<	1
