A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF SURF CITY TO REPLACE A WATER LINE

- 3 WITH ITS OWN CREW AND EQUIPMENT.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 143-135 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 143-135. Limitation of application of Article.

Except for the provisions of G.S. 143-129 requiring bids for the purchase of 7 apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment, this Article shall not apply to construction 8 or repair work undertaken by the State or by subdivisions of the State of North Carolina 9 when the work is performed by duly elected officers or agents using force 10 (i) account gualified labor on the permanent payroll of the agency concerned and (ii) when 11 the total cost of the project, including without limitation all direct and indirect costs of 12 labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment, does not exceed seventy-five 13 thousand dollars (\$75,000). two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000). Such force 14 account work shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget in the case 15 of State agencies, of the responsible commission, council, or board in the case of 16 subdivisions of the State. Complete and accurate records of the entire cost of such 17 work, including without limitation, all direct and indirect costs of labor, services, 18 materials, supplies and equipment performed and furnished in the prosecution and 19 completion thereof, shall be maintained by such agency, commission, council or board 20 for the inspection by the general public. Construction or repair work undertaken 21 pursuant to this section shall not be divided for the purposes of evading the provisions 22 of this Article." 23

- Sec. 2. This act applies to the Town of Surf City only.

- 1 Sec. 3. This act applies only to the replacement of an old six-inch military 2 water line running approximately one mile through the center of town.
- 3 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification and expires one year from that 4 date.
