HOUSE BILL 835

Short Title: Firearms/Durham County Property.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REGULATE THE POSSESSION AND USE OF FIREARMS ON
3 PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY DURHAM COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. It is unlawful to:

- 6 (1) Carry any firearm into; or
7 (2) Have in one's possession any firearm while on

8 the premises of any:

- 9 (1) Building or facility owned; or
10 (2) Portion of a building leased and occupied for governmental use

11 by the County of Durham.

12 Sec. 2. This act does not apply to:

- 13 (1) Firing ranges and training facilities designated as such by resolution of
14 the Board of Commissioners;
15 (2) Hunter safety or shooter safety:
16 a. Courses; and
17 b. Demonstrations;
18 (3) Law enforcement officers or members of the armed forces, acting in
19 the line of duty; and
20 (4) Use of firearms pursuant to the lawful direction of law enforcement
21 officers.

22 Sec. 3. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not
23 more than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) or by imprisonment for not more than 30
24 days, or both.

- 1 Sec. 4. This act applies to Durham County only.
- 2 Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
