| 5  | Section 1. It is unlawful to possess or carry, openly or concealed, any firearm        |
| 6  | while on the premises of any building or facility, or portion thereof, which is owned, |
| 7  | leased, or used for any governmental purpose by the County of Durham.                  |
| 8  | Sec. 2. This act does not apply to:  |
| 9  | (1) Firing ranges and training facilities designated as such by resolution of          |
| 10 | the Board of Commissioners;  |
| 11 | (2) Hunter safety or shooter safety:   |
| 12 | a. Courses; and  |
| 13 | b. Demonstrations;   |
| 14 | (3) Military training programs or ceremonies authorized by the United                  |
| 15 | States, by the State, or by the County of Durham;                                      |
| 16 | (4) Law enforcement officers or members of the armed forces, acting in                 |
| 17 | the line of duty; and  |
| 18 | (5) Use of firearms pursuant to the lawful direction of law enforcement                |
| 19 | officers.  |
| 20 | Sec. 3. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not            |
| 21 | more than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) or by imprisonment for not more than 30 |
| 22 | days, or both.   |
| 23 | Sec. 4. This act applies to Durham County only.  |
