A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRATION OF OUT-OF-STATE PHARMACIES
2 THAT REGULARLY DISTRIBUTE PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES TO
3 CITIZENS OF THE STATE THROUGH THE MAIL OR OTHER COMMON
4 CARRIERS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Article 4A of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by
8 adding a new section to read:

9 "**§ 90-85.21.1. Applicability to out-of-state operations.**

10 Any pharmacy operating outside the State which ships, mails, or delivers in any
11 manner a dispensed legend drug into this State shall hold a pharmacy license issued by
12 the Board, and that part of the pharmacy operation dispensing the prescription for a
13 North Carolina resident shall abide by North Carolina law and the Board's rules and
14 regulations."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
