There is appropriated from the Worker Training Trust Fund to Tri-16 County Industries, Inc., the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 1993-94 17 fiscal year and the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to 18
