A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW PROJECTS FINANCED UNDER THE INDUSTRIAL AND POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITIES FINANCING ACT AND THE NORTH CAROLINA INDUSTRIAL AND POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITIES POOL PROGRAM FINANCING ACT TO BE LOCATED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 159C-10 reads as rewritten:

"§ 159C-10. Location of projects.

~~Any~~ Except as provided in this section, any project or projects of an authority shall be located within the boundaries of the county for which the authority was created. A portion or portions of any project including, but not limited to, any real or personal property or improvements necessary or convenient for the construction, maintenance, and operation of the project, may be located in a county or counties other than the county for which the authority was created so long as the additional portion or portions constitute functionally appurtenant or incidental facilities and the governing body of each other county in which the additional portion or portions of the project is or are located approves the project."

Sec. 2. G.S. 159D-10 reads as rewritten:

"§ 159D-10. Location of projects.

~~Any~~ Except as provided in this section, any project of the authority shall be located within the boundaries of a county which is a member of the authority. A portion or portions of any project including, but not limited to, any real or personal property or

1 improvements necessary or convenient for the construction, maintenance, and operation
2 of the project, may be located in a county or counties other than the county for which
3 the authority was created so long as the additional portion or portions constitute
4 functionally appurtenant or incidental facilities and the governing body of each other
5 county in which the additional portion or portions of the project is or are located
6 approves the project."

7 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
