SENATE BILL 1667

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING UNION COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A TOURISM BOARD
OR AUTHORITY FOR THE PROMOTION OF TRAVEL AND TOURISM
WITHIN UNION COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Union County Board of Commissioners may by resolution establish a tourism board or authority to promote travel and tourism within Union County. The board or authority shall be created pursuant to G.S. 158-8, except that the membership, duration of service, powers, and duties of the board or authority shall be fixed by resolution of the board of commissioners. The resolution establishing a tourism board or authority may be modified, amended, or repealed in the same manner as it was originally adopted. G.S. 158-7.1 and G.S. 158-12 authorize the Union County Board of Commissioners to appropriate funds not otherwise limited as to use by law for the purpose of promoting travel and tourism within Union County.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
