**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE  
RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT AND PRESIDENT PRO  
TEMPORE OF THE SENATE.**

Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the President of the Senate or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

Whereas, the President of the Senate and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate have made recommendations; Now, therefore,  
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**PART 1. PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE**

Section 1. Susan B. Roderick of Buncombe County is appointed to the Board of Directors of the Western North Carolina Arboretum for a term expiring June 30, 1998.

Sec. 2. Debi Harrill of Cleveland County and Diana J. Wilson of Chowan County are appointed to the Child-Day Care Commission for a term expiring June 30, 1996. Debi Harrill is a categorical appointment for a person affiliated with a for-profit child day care center. Diana J. Wilson is a categorical appointment for a person affiliated with a nonprofit center or home.

Sec. 3. Kim Dove of Wake County is appointed to the North Carolina Board of Dietetics/Nutrition for a term expiring June 30, 1997. This is a categorical appointment for a licensed dietitian/nutritionist.

1           Sec. 4. Regina L. Hopkins of Lenoir County is appointed to the Low-Level  
2 Radioactive Waste Management Authority for a term ending June 30, 1998.

3           Sec. 5. James Vann of Person County is appointed to the Board of Trustees  
4 of the Teachers' and State Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan for a term  
5 ending June 30, 1996.

6           Sec. 6. Kathy Barger of Pitt County is appointed to the North Carolina  
7 Medical Database Commission for a term ending June 30, 1997. This is a categorical  
8 appointment for a hospital administrator.

9           Sec. 7. Ken Haigler of Pitt County is appointed to the North Carolina State  
10 Ports Authority for a term ending June 30, 1996.

11          Sec. 8. Sherman Guillyard of Bladen County is appointed to the Private  
12 Protective Services Board for a term ending June 30, 1997.

13          Sec. 9. Teresa Smallwood of Bertie County and Vernice B. Howard of  
14 Hertford County are appointed to the Rules Review Commission for terms ending June  
15 30, 1996.

16          Sec. 10. John Talbot Johnson of Moore County is appointed to the State  
17 Building Commission for a term ending June 30, 1997.

18          Sec. 11. Wayne Pollock of Durham County is appointed to the State Board of  
19 Therapeutic Recreation Certification Board for a term ending June 30, 1995. This is a  
20 categorical appointment for a recreation therapist.

21          Sec. 12. Lula Herring of Pender County is appointed to the State Board of  
22 Therapeutic Recreation Certification Board for a term ending June 30, 1997. This is a  
23 categorical appointment for a public member to the Board.

25 **PART 2. PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE**

26          Sec. 13. Senators Beverly Perdue of Craven County and J. Richard Conder of  
27 Richmond County are appointed to the North Carolina Travel and Tourism Board for  
28 terms beginning on January 1, 1995, and expiring on December 31, 1996. Ward Barnett  
29 of Dare County and Barry Higgs of Swain County are appointed to the North Carolina  
30 Travel and Tourism Board for terms beginning on January 1, 1995, and expiring on  
31 December 31, 1996.

32          Sec. 14. Judy Seamon of Carteret County and Barbara Morris of Harnett  
33 County are appointed to the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Center for  
34 Nursing for terms expiring June 30, 1997.

35          Sec. 15. Unless otherwise specified, all appointments made by this act are for  
36 terms to begin upon ratification.

37          Sec. 16. This act is effective upon ratification.
