CHAPTER 406 SENATE BILL 219

AN ACT TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA REPORT TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS ON VENDING OPERATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-36.4 reads as rewritten:

"§ 116-36.4. Vending facilities.

The Board of Governors shall, not later than October 1 of each year, <u>make-review</u> an itemized annual report in a format to be determined by the Office of State Budget and Management to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations concerning the use of net proceeds from operations of vending facilities for the previous fiscal year under G.S. 116-36.1. Net proceeds may be used only as authorized by the Board of Governors, but this section does not authorize expenditures for purposes not otherwise authorized by law. The report shall be <u>broken down-itemized</u> by campus and by authorized purpose. The Board shall also review an annual report from the UNC Hospitals, monitoring compliance with G.S. 143-12.1(f1). A copy of the report shall be provided to the Fiscal Research Division of the Legislative Services Office."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 1993.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 20th day of July, 1993.
