SENATE BILL 222

Short Title: Macon Deer Hunting.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM, ON, OR ACROSS THE RIGHT-OF-
2 WAY OF A PUBLIC ROAD OR HIGHWAY IN MACON COUNTY DURING
3 DEER SEASON.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. It is unlawful to discharge a firearm from, on, or across the right-
7 of-way of any public road, street, or highway during the seasons for taking deer with
8 firearms.

9 Sec. 2. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor punishable for a first
10 conviction by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one
11 hundred dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, and punishable
12 for a second conviction within one year by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars
13 (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), by imprisonment of not more
14 than 90 days, or by both.

15 Sec. 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife
16 Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with
17 general subject matter jurisdiction.

18 Sec. 4. This act applies only to Macon County.

19 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
