The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by				
adding a new section to read:				
"§ 143-10.3. Development of performance measures for major programs. (a) The Director of the Budget, through the Office of State Budget, the Office of				
(a) The Director of the Budget, through the Office of State Budget, the Office of State Policy and Planning and State agencies, departments, and institutions, shall				
develop performance measures for the major programs for each State agency,				
department, and institution. These performance measures shall be developed as part of				
the biennial comprehensive plan and serve as the basis for the development of the				
biennial budget, beginning with the 1995-97 fiscal biennium.				
(b) The Director shall institute a standard process for developing program				
performance measures and for monitoring performance results, uniform performance				

- (c) The program performance measurement system shall include:
- (1) Description of the key performance measures for the program.

 Performance measures should include: program efficiency or unit cost, outputs or program activity, and outcomes or performance results, with emphasis on the use of program outcome measures.
