4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-218(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a school bus loaded 7 with children over the highways or public vehicular areas of North Carolina at a greater 8 rate of speed than 35-45 miles per hour, with the following exceptions:

9	(1)	For-except that school activity buses which are painted a different color
10		from regular school buses and which are being used for transportation
11		of students or others to or from places for participation in events other
12		than regular classroom work, it shall be unlawful to operate such a
13		school activity bus at a greater rate of speed than 55 miles per hour.
14	<del>(2)</del>	For school buses or special buses with a capacity of 16 pupils or less
15		that are used to transport students who are children with special needs,
16		it shall be unlawful to operate the buses at a greater rate of speed than
17		45 miles per hour.
18	(3)	For private school buses that pick up children at a central point and
19		deposit the children at a single school, without picking up children
20		along the way, it shall be unlawful to operate the buses at a greater rate
21		of speed than 45 miles per hour."
