A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, North Carolina Council for Women, the sum of two million one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$2,145,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two million one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$2,145,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the prevention of domestic violence and the continuation of domestic violence programs within the State, to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$15,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year and \$15,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used for a grant-in-aid to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Incorporated;
- \$1,980,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year and \$1,980,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year shall be evenly divided and used as grants-in-aid of \$30,000 each year of the biennium for the operation of each of the 66 domestic violence programs in operation on January 1, 1993, and providing services, including a 24-hour crisis line, community education, victim advocacy, support services, and other services;
- (3) \$150,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year and \$150,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the development of new domestic violence programs. The North Carolina Council for Women may award grants of up to \$30,000.
