The Charter of the Town of Grifton, being Chapter 480 of the 7 Session Laws of 1975, is amended by adding a new Section 8-4 to Chapter VIII to read: 8 "Sec. 8-4. Extraterritorial jurisdiction. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 9 160A-360, the Town of Grifton may exercise the extraterritorial jurisdiction powers 10 granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes within a defined area 11 extending not more than two miles beyond the corporate limits." 12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 13
