A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO EXEMPT MECKLENBURG COUNTY FROM PROVISIONS OF THE
NORTH CAROLINA BUILDING CODE THAT REQUIRE BUILDING
INSPECTION DEPARTMENTS TO REVIEW RESIDENTIAL PLANS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a county shall not be required to review and approve detailed residential building plans submitted to the county pursuant to Section R-110 of Volume VII of the North Carolina State Building Code; provided that the county shall require and review such residential building plans as it deems necessary.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
