Any hospital or other health care facility licensed pursuant to this Chapter or 10 Chapter 122C of the General Statutes or any health maintenance organization providing 11 patient counseling by a physician, a registered nurse, or any other appropriately trained 12 health care professional shall be deemed in compliance with the rules adopted by the 13 North Carolina Board of Pharmacy regarding patient counseling. 14 As used in this section, 'patient counseling' means the effective 15 communication of information to the patient or representative in order to improve 16 therapeutic outcomes by maximizing proper use of prescription medications and 17
